Student Transportation Services

Public charter school transportation services will be provided by the school's sponsor for students to and from public charter school and may be for public charter school-sponsored field trips that are extensions of classroom learning experiences. Transportation will be provided for students experiencing homelessness to and from the student's school of origin¹ as required by the Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 (ESSA). These services shall be provided throughout the regularly scheduled year and during the regular school day as determined by the transportation provider.

Miles from public charter school will be determined by the transportation provider in accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 581-023-0040(1)(e).

School buses carrying students will be considered extensions of the school experience. All students using public charter school transportation will abide by the code of conduct posted in each school bus. Violations of such code, as well as other conduct which is improper or which jeopardizes the safety of self or others, will be reported by the school bus driver to the transportation provider. The transportation provider will, as soon as possible, inform the appropriate public charter school executive director of such occurrence. Violators may be denied use of transportation for a period of time as deemed proper by the public charter school executive director and/or transportation provider.

The public charter school executive director or designee shall ensure transportation officials and drivers receive notification of students having special medical or behavioral protocols identified in student records.

^{1 &}quot;School of origin" means the school that a student attended when permanently housed or the school in which the student was last enrolled.

When the student has completed the final grade served by the school of origin, the term "school of origin" shall include the designated receiving school at the next grade level for all feeder schools.
